The following items are intended to describe the highlights and decisions of the meeting and are not necessarily presented in the order in which they occurred.

Item No.	Discussion and Determinations	Action Items
1.	Confirmed all bidders have received Addendum #2-REVISED, dated August 22, 2024.	
2.	Generic contract will be uploaded to the RFP site by Griffin Hospital.	
3.	Clarification by Nancy Marini that liquidated damages commence after the completion date stated in Successful Contractor's Bid Proposal.	



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- 4. Sequencing was discussed such that any work that can be performed early should be done:
 - *a. Installation of the new fuel oil piping, pumping system and polishing system.*
 - b. Installation of the Sprinkler work.
 - c. Removal of Generator #2 (250kW) can be removed once all loads currently fed from it have been transferred as outlined in Proposed Sequence of construction. This will enable removal of the exhaust flue to be removed early.
- Upon visiting the roof, discussion regarding the possible enlargement of the thimble may be required. Roofing work shall be done by New England Masonry & Roofing, 146 Sheridan Dr, Naugatuck, CT 06770 (203) 729-2266 / www.nemasonry.com
- 6. For coordination purposes, Griffin Hospital will confirm lead times for the new Transfer Switches and the new Switchboard EQESBB.
- 7. For the purposes of containment exhaust on 2nd and 3rd floors when working on removal/replacement of new generator exhaust flue, there are two locations available, preferred would be through them balcony door to the southeast of the work area, the second would be through a "removable" window in the sitting area to the northeast of the work area.
- 8. The question of permitting difficulties with the town for using a crane was raised. Griffin Hospital has always worked closely with the town and has no reason to believe that there will be any problem in obtaining permit(s) for using a crane to rig the equipment in and out through the areaway.
